Sir,

Global Parli started by Mayank Gandhi is a mission of rural transformation. It has embarked on a journey of changing the face of rural India through a deliberate and intelligently crafted "Rural Economic Transformation" model. It is primarily working in rural area for uplifting lives of villagers.

As a proof of concept Global Parli has worked in 106 villages of drought-hit and suicide prone Marathwada, Maharashtra. Since 2016 Global Parli has achieved the following progress in various fields: -

- In 2016- Global Parli supplied 1.54 crore litre of water.
- In 2017- Global Parli initiated 360 degree development.
- In 2018- Global Parli created water capacity of 222 crore litre.
- In 2019- Global Parli planted 1.2 million fruit trees in Marathwada
- In 2020- Global Parli planted 2.3 million fruit trees in Maharashtra & Madhya Pradesh.

2019 and 2020: Traditional crops like cotton and soya were only giving an annual income of Rs. 10,000 to Rs. 20,000 per acre. This was the reason for farm distress, poverty and suicides. Changing cropping patterns to remunerative crops along with a push for intercropping was the way forward.

We started a movement. A movement fuelled by some of India's top experts, agronomists, successful farmers, agro-industries, and academics. A movement against poverty, rural distress, droughts, suicide and social unrest.

We have used three important strategies to increase incomes through mass plantation

- 1. Changing cropping pattern and giving multiple rounds of training.
- 2. Supply and sourcing of best quality of appropriate plants and enhancing technology by marrying traditional methods with modern agriculture practices and training
- 3. Planting cluster wise at such large scale that instead of going to market, the market comes to the farm.

Last year, 11.87 lakh fruit trees like Custard apple, Guava, Lemon, Drumsticks, Lemon, Papaya etc. were planted by farmers. This year, we have planted over 20 lac fruit trees in Maharashtra and Marathwada. The "Rural Economic Transformation" model has proven to be immensely successful. Hundred of farmers have reported multiplication of annual incomes from Rs. 15000-Rs. 20000 per acre to at least Rs 2 lakh per acre, a tenfold increase.

In 2020, we intend to undertake multiple activities in Marathwada and in Madhya Pradesh. We are also in discussion with various organization in other states for replicating and scaling up our model. We seek your help and donation for the above project for Rs 50 lac. This would cover the following expenses: - Cost of sapling, transport, delivery, labor, soil, maintenance and monitoring, subsidy training, administration etc. The estimated cost per plant would be Rs 25/- and we would be able to plant 2,00,000 saplings with the support of your donation.
